### Ski/ Snowboard/ Explore "MUST KNOW" Information

1. Bus leaves each location SHARP! There will be no refunds if you sleep in or miss the bus.
2. On the way up – SLEEP! Arrange for someone to pick you up at the designated location, on time.
3. Eating is allowed on the bus if kept tidy.
4. Never wear ski boots on the bus. Boots should be stored on the floor, or in the luggage compartment. Do not lean skis or snowboards against the bus.
5. Wear appropriate clothing. Clothing should adapt to any weather changes. A sunny day can quickly turn into a windy blizzard. The key is to wear layers of clothing so it can be added or removed to accommodate temperature and condition changes. The following is a checklist of necessary ski and snowboard clothing: **warm jacket, sun screen/lip protection, turtleneck shirt, fleece or sweater, neck tube, long underwear, water resistant ski pants, warm ski socks, hat and helmet, water resistant gloves or mitts, goggles or sunglasses.**
6. The renter shall take full responsibility for the care of the rental equipment, and agrees to replace at full retail value any equipment not returned by the end of each ski session.
7. The cost of lockers is included in the package. They are outside, so make sure the contents of your bags won't freeze.
8. Don't leave expensive clothes or equipment unguarded. They could be lost or stolen.
9. Carry your medical card / care card or a copy with you, as well as school I.D.
- 10. IN CASE OF INJURY OR ACCIDENT, ALERT THE SKI PATROL OR A LIFT OPERATOR OR YOUR INSTRUCTOR. DO NOT LEAVE THE MOUNTAIN WITHOUT LETTING THE SKI PATROL KNOW THAT YOU ARE A DELTA SCHOOL DISTRICT INTERNATIONAL STUDENT AND THAT THEY MUST NOTIFY SCHOOL DISTRICT STAFF THAT YOU ARE HURT.**
11. You are to stay with your group from the time we reach Base II until you return on the bus.
12. All school rules apply. Smoking or poor behaviour is not acceptable.
13. Obey all mountain signs.
14. **EVERYONE** comes with the school and leaves with the school – DO NOT go home with a sister, brother, mother, friend. **We do not leave for home until everyone is accounted for.**
15. Allow LOTS of time to get back to the bus by 3:00 p.m. The bus leaves at 3:30 SHARP. You will be charged \$90.00 per hour if the bus must wait for you. That's \$1.50 per minute per tardy person!
16. The bus will stay in Whistler, so you will be able to leave gear on the bus, but you will not be able to get back on the bus until 2:30 p.m.
17. Staff will be on the hill, in touch with cell phone in case of emergency.
18. All students ride/ski with their own helmet regardless of ability. In the event that your son/daughter does not own a helmet, Whistler/Blackcomb has enough CSA approved helmets to outfit every student in the Ride Tribe Schools program free of charge.
19. In the event that a student cannot attend he or she must give a minimum of 5 business days notice to Ms. Hamilton (604-952-5394) prior to the trip (Monday the 13th at 9 am) as booking confirmation must be sent to Whistler/Blackcomb in advance of each trip.
